SCHOOL SPORT SURVEY: ADDED BONUS COMPETITION
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Promoter

The Promoter of the competition is: Sports Council for Wales (trading as Sport Wales) a company incorporated by Royal Charter and whose registered office is at Sport Wales National Centre, Sophia Gardens, Cardiff, CF11 9SW.

2. The Competition and the Prize

2.1. The title of the competition is School Sport Survey Added Bonus. The competition involves Welsh primary, secondary, middle and special schools (with pupils aged between 7 and 16 years) participating in the School Sport Survey to the extent that they qualify for a school-level or short-report.

2.2. The winning schools will receive £250 towards improving sport and physical activity for their pupils. The £250 will be delivered as a cheque.

2.3. The prize is as stated and no cash or other alternatives will be offered. The prize is not transferable, is subject to availability and the Promoter reserve the right to substitute the prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice.

2.4. One Primary School and one Secondary School from each of the four regions will be chosen as winners. Regions are classified as North (Ynys Mon, Gwynedd, Conwy, Denbighshire, Flintshire and Wrexham), Mid & West (Powys, Pembrokeshire, Swansea, Carmarthenshire, Ceredigion, Neath Port Talbot), South East (Monmouthshire, Newport, Torfaen, Caerphilly, Blaenau Gwent) and Central South (Bridgend, Cardiff, Merthyr Tydfil, Rhondda Cynon Taf, Vale of Glamorgan).

2.5. For the prize draw Middle Schools and Special Schools will automatically go into the category (primary, secondary or both) reflective of their pupil age range.

3. How To Enter

3.1. To participate, schools will need to:

3.1.1. Participate in the School Sport Survey via the unique link that has been sent directly to them via email. All schools in Wales with pupils aged 7-16 years will have provided with such link. More information about this can be gained from schoolsportsurvey@sportwales.org.uk

3.1.2. Qualify for a school-level or short-report (as agreed with Sport Wales) by submitting the correct amount of responses to the survey. More information about required response levels (which is unique to each school based on population data) can be gained from schoolsportsurvey@sportwales.org.uk

3.2. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.

3.3. The competition entrant is the school. The school must be located in Wales. By entering the competition, a duly authorised teacher or other employee, acting on behalf of the school, is indicating that they have read and understood these terms and conditions and the school agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions.

- 3.5. Multiple entries from the same school cannot be made. Only one prize per school is permitted.
- 3.6. The competition entry period will run from the start of Sport Wales' School Sport Survey response period (16th April 2018) until the closing of the response period (20th July 2018).
- 3.7. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received by the Deadline for whatever reason.
- 3.8. All schools qualifying for the school-level or short report (as agreed by Sport Wales) will automatically be entered into the competition.

4. Winner Announcement and Claiming the Prize

- 4.1. The winners will be chosen: at random by Sport Wales from all entries received and verified by the Promoter.
- 4.2. The winner will be notified by Direct Message on Twitter and/or Facebook and/or email and/or telephone during the Autumn 2018 school term (starting September 2018), the Promoter reserves the right to withdraw the prize from the winner and pick a replacement winner.
- 4.3. The Promoter will notify the winner when and how the prize will be delivered.
- 4.4. The winner's name will also be available by emailing the following address: communications@sport.wales.
- 4.5. The Promoter's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 4.6. The Promoter is not responsible for inaccurate prize details supplied to any entrant by any third party connected with this competition.
